



The FA Football Agent Regulations 2026/27

Guidance related to Agents performing Football Agent Services under a Representation Agreement

1. Introduction

From **1st June 2026**, the FA Football Agent Regulations (“the Regulations”) permit FA Registered Football Agents employed by the same Agency as an FA Registered Football Agent who is party to a Representation Agreement to assist in delivering Football Agent Services under an existing Representation Agreement.

This document should be read in conjunction with the Regulations, in particular Regulation 4.1(b).

2. General Responsibilities

Under Regulation 3.3, the FA Registered Football Agent who is party to the Representation Agreement (“the Principal Agent”) is responsible for ensuring that all Football Agent Services performed in relation to that agreement are carried out only by FA Registered Football Agents.

Any FA Registered Football Agent performing Football Agent Services in respect of a Transaction must comply with all applicable provisions of the Regulations, including but not limited to Regulation 6.2.

3. Conditions for assistance by other FA Registered Football Agents

Where an FA Registered Football Agent (“Assisting Agent”) wishes to perform Football Agent Services in circumstances where:

- a different FA Registered Football Agent employed by the same Agency has entered into a Representation Agreement with a Player, Coach or Club; and
- the Agency is also party to that Representation Agreement,

the following conditions apply:

1. FA Registration Requirement

- The Assisting Agent must be an FA Registered Football Agent at the time of performing any services.
- The Assisting Agent must have joined the Agency on The FA Agents Portal.

2. Employment by the Agency

- The Assisting Agent must be **employed** by the same Agency that is party to the Representation Agreement.

3. Representation Agreement

- The Agency must be a party to the Representation Agreement in addition to the Principal Agent.
- There must be written consent from all parties regarding the provision of services by other FA Registered Football Agents employed by the Agency.

4. Representation Agreements Involving Minors

- Where the Representation Agreement concerns a Minor, the Assisting Agent must have complied with all relevant provisions of the Regulations relating to Minors.

5. Scope of Permitted Assistance

- The Assisting Agent may only assist the Principal Agent in performing the specific Football Agent Services set out in the Representation Agreement.

6. Continuing Obligations of the Principal Agent

- The Principal Agent retains all obligations arising under the Representation Agreement and under the Regulations.

7. Tripartite Agreements

- Where it is in respect of a Tripartite Agreement, the Principal Agent to the Representation Agreement with the Player or Coach should be the principal party to the Tripartite Agreement.

8. Completion of a Transaction

- At the conclusion of a Transaction:
 - The Principal Agent must complete the relevant Agent Form.
 - All other FA Registered Football Agents who performed any Football Agent Services must also complete the relevant Agent Form.

4. Existing Player/Coach Representation Agreements

- For Representation Agreements with Players or Coaches already in force where the Agency is a party, and where the parties now wish to permit additional FA Registered Football Agents employed by the Agency to assist in providing Football Agent Services:
 - Parties may amend the existing agreement to include written consent from all parties regarding the provision of services by other FA Registered Football Agents employed by the Agency.
 - The amendment must be uploaded to The FA Agents Portal against the original Representation Agreement.
