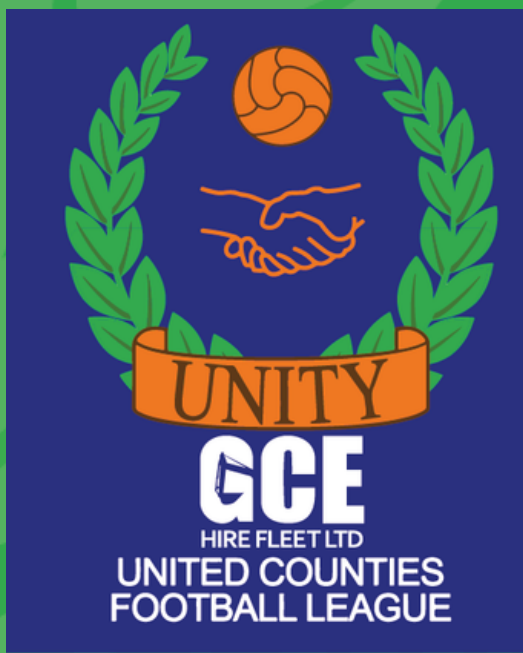

Match Day Reminders

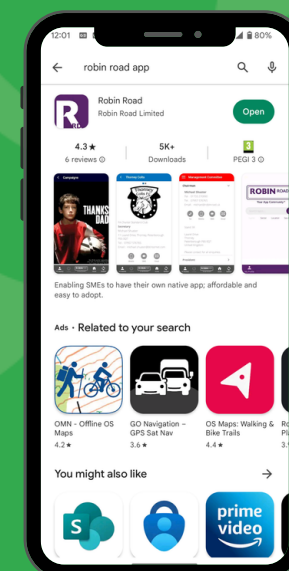


Please ensure home Clubs advise the visiting Club and the Match Officials of the date and time of kick-off of each match and the team colours, including the colour of the goalkeeper's jersey, it will be wearing, to be received at least five days prior to the match and the visiting Club and the Match Officials must acknowledge receipt to be received at least three days before the match.

As per Rule 42 In matches involving Premier Division/Division One teams, Clubs must provide sandwiches and tea/coffee, or other similar light refreshments, at half time for Club Officials. All Clubs must provide liquid refreshments for match officials at half time and full time, and prior to the match on request. In addition sandwiches and tea/coffee, or other similar light refreshments, must be provided at the end of all matches.

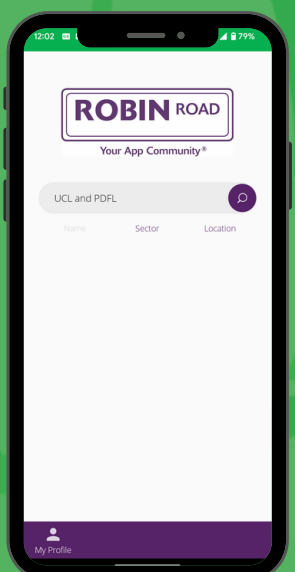
Robin Road App
